Reconstitution of Mycophenolate Suspension

Your pet was prescribed mycophenolate, a liquid immunosuppressant for certain conditions. This medication is good for only **60 days** after mixing.

In order to reconstitute this medication, you will need the following:

- Bottle of Mycophenolate suspension
- 20 mL syringe
- Small cup or bowl
- Plain tap water (cool or room temperature, not warm)

Directions:

1. Remove the plastic cap from bottle.
2. Fill a small cup or bowl with plain water from the tap.
3. Using the syringe provided, insert the syringe tip below the surface of the water in the cup and draw 11.75 mL of water into the syringe by retracting the plastic plunger. Align the top of the black inner plug (just below the cone) with the 11.75 mL mark.
4. Add the 11.75 mL of water to the powder in the bottle, replace the cap, and shake well. *Check the bottom of the bottle of chunks of dry powder and loosen them by shaking.*
5. Repeat step 4. The amount of 11.75 mL needs to be added to the powder two times, for a **total of 23.5 mL added**. *Shake well.*
6. Store reconstituted suspension at room temperature, shake before every use, and **discard in 60 days**.
