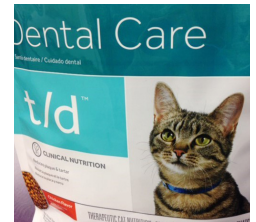
LOOK FOR THE VOHC ACCEPTED LABEL

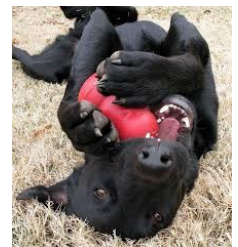

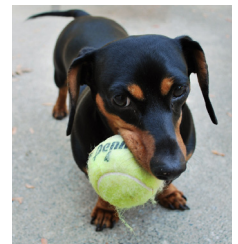
